So the lion left the rabbit and went to catch the deer. The deer ran fast.

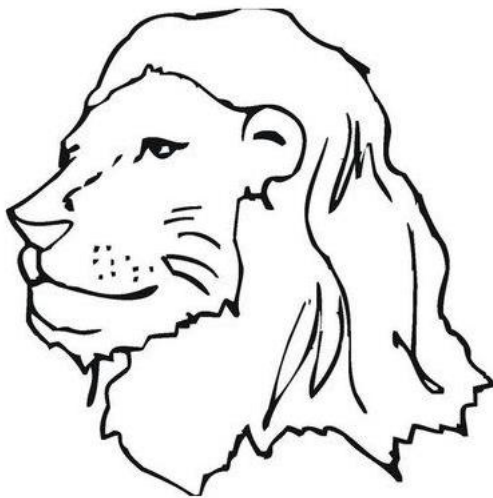
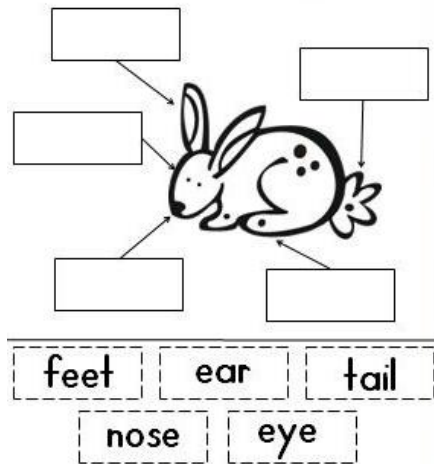
The lion could not catch it. So it thought, "I will go back and catch the rabbit".

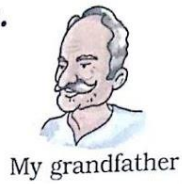
